Flexible Sigmoidoscopy Instructions

Blood thinners: (If applicable) Please contact your prescribing physician two weeks before your procedure to ask how long you can be off your blood thinner medication(s) before your procedure.

Insulin dependent diabetics: (If applicable) Please contact your prescribing physician two weeks before your procedure for direction on insulin dosing for the procedure.

If you're on certain medications called GLP-1 agonists, you will follow the below instructions for procedure. GLP-1 agonists include:

- Dulaglutide (Trulicity)
- Exenatide extended release (Bydureon bcise)
- Exenatide (Byetta)
- Semaglutide (Ozempic)
- Liraglutide (Victoza, Saxenda)
- Lixisenatide (Adlyxin)
- Semaglutide (Rybelsus)

GLP-1 Agonists: (If applicable) Patients taking GLP-1 agonists daily – Hold on the day of the procedure. Patients taking GLP-1 agonists weekly – Hold for 1 week prior to the procedure. Clear liquids **ONLY** the day prior to the procedure.



Please follow a low-residue diet for 3 days prior to your procedure. Please avoid raw fruits and vegetables, as well as whole grains, nuts, and seeds.

Purchase 2 Fleet Enemas at the pharmacy.

Day before the procedure:

- Between 5-6 pm have a LIGHT DINNER of soft foods. Eggs, pasta (no red sauce), broiled chicken, fish, mashed potatoes would be fine. (No milk, cream, raw fruits, or vegetables). You can have a low residue breakfast and lunch. **If you are taking a GLP-1 clear liquids only the before the procedure.
- Nothing to eat after midnight.

Day of the procedure:

- Drink clear liquids ONLY. NO FOOD
 - Examples of clear liquids: Powerade, Gatorade, bouillon, broth, consommé, black tea, black coffee, apple juice, white grape juice, white cranberry juice, Crystal Light, water, Italian ice, popsicles, sorbet or jello.
 Nothing red or purple. No milk or cream. Discontinue two hours before arrival.
 - Two Fleet's enemas used a half hour apart to be completed 2 hours prior to arrival tine.
- **DO NOT** take diabetic pills or diuretics (water pills) the morning of the procedure.
- **Nothing by mouth** two (2) hours before arrival.
- **2 hours before your arrival time** Take 1 Fleet Enema then 30 minutes later take the 2nd Fleet Enema.

You will need a responsible driver (18 years of age or older) to drive you home if you are sedated for the procedure.

Expect to be here for 90 minutes to 2 hours.
